

Introduction

THE BEGINNING OF MATTHEW'S GOSPEL INTRODUCES US TO JESUS, WHO HE IS AND HOW HIS MINISTRY STARTED.

The first two chapters tell the story of Jesus' birth, the visit of the Magi and the family's escape to Egypt.

Chapters three and four tell us about the ministry of John the Baptist, Jesus' baptism and temptation, his first disciples, and the beginning of his ministry.

TOPICS COVERED

The eleven Bible studies in this series look at the following topics: The people used by God; obedience; King Jesus; insecurity and jealousy; dreams; repentance; baptism; temptation; light; following Jesus; the good news of the Kingdom.

BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

Each Bible study has four questions. The four questions follow a model based on the anagram READ.

1. Research

Look at the Bible text in more detail.

2. Explore

Look for themes throughout the Bible.

3. Apply

Look back at examples from your own life or those around you.

4. **Do**

Look forward to the future, and plan any changes you need to make.


Matthew 1:18-25

How do you feel when someone else gets more attention than you or gets promoted ahead of you?	Do you have any insecurities that are affecting the way you treat other people? Bring them to God in prayer and ask for his help and forgiveness.




Matthew 2:19-23

How many times did God speak to Joseph in a dream? What messages did God give him?	In the book of Genesis, God spoke to several people in dreams (See, for example — Genesis 20:3-7; 28:10-17; 31:10-13 & 24; 37:5-11; 40:1-23; 41:1- 40) What did God say to them? What changes happened in their lives as a result of those dreams?
Have you ever had a significant dream that you remember?	Ask God if there's anything he wants to say to you today.




Matthew 3:1-12

What does this passage tell us about repentance?	Read Luke 3:7-14. What are the fruits of repentance?
Has God ever challenged you to repent	Ask God if there is anything he wants
of something? What did you change?	you to change in your life.



Matthew 3:13-17

Why did Jesus get baptised? What happened to him as he came up out of the water?	How important was baptism to the early church, and what did it mean to them? (See, for example — Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:37-41; Romans 6:1-4)
Have you been baptised? How did your experience compare to the baptisms described in the Bible?	Jesus heard a voice from heaven saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him, I am well pleased." Ask God to reveal the depth of His love for Jesus and for you (1 John 4:9-10).




Matthew 4:1-11

What were the three temptations Jesus faced? Why do you think the Holy Spirit led Jesus out into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil?	Read Hebrews 4:15. What other temptations do you think Jesus experienced?

Matthew 4:12-17

How was Jesus' arrival in Galilee like	Read Isaiah 9:1-7. How did Jesus fulfil
the dawning of a new day?	Isaiah's prophecy?
Are there any areas of your life that seem dark or confused? Can you think of a time when you lived "under the shadow of death"?	Ask God to shine his light into the dark areas of your life. Are there any changes he wants you to make?



Matthew 4:18-22

What similarities are there between catching fish and being a fisher of men?	When Jesus called people to follow him, what did he ask them to leave behind (See, for example — Matthew 8:19-22; Mark 10:21; Luke 5:27-28)?
What have you left behind to follow	Ask God to help you follow him
Jesus? What would you find most	wholeheartedly. Is there is anything
difficult to give up?	that he wants you to give up?



Matthew 4:23-25


Jesus began his ministry in Galilee. What three things did he do? (v23) Why do you think Jesus was followed by such large crowds?	The word Gospel means 'good news'. What is the good news of the kingdom (v23)?
